2022 NECA Trade Teacher Awards Assessment Criteria

Excellence in Teaching:

Definition:

- Establishing and maintaining a stimulating learning environment and encouraging students to exceed their own expectations.
- Demonstrating an in-depth and up to date knowledge of both learning and assessment and industry practices.

Evidence – *these are examples of what the judges will be looking for:*

- Involvement in professional development/growth activities.
- Working with colleagues to share and evaluate teaching practice.
- Positive student results.
- Industry and business connections.

Innovative Practice:

Definition:

- Developing new teaching methods or devices or adapting better practices from elsewhere into trade teaching in order to improve outcomes for students and industry.

Evidence – *these are examples of what the judges will be looking for:*

- Using unique approaches to teaching and training, or practices adapted from elsewhere to produce better results.
- Developing high quality teacher resources or materials.
- Championing best practice through teacher and employer networks.
- Examples of vision or leadership leading to excellent outcomes.

Client Satisfaction – clients include both learners and employers:

Definition:

- Proven ability to work with industry and employers to develop flexible and effective training programs.
- Proven ability to mentor students according to their individual needs in order to achieve high levels of competence.

Evidence – *these are examples of what the judges will be looking for:*

- Employer and student testimonials (references).
- Effective employer and industry networks.
- High student retention and completion rates.
- Effective assessment of Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL).
- Support for students through difficulties – workplace, family or learning.
- Delivering training in flexible ways e.g. on-line, after hours or on-site.
