1. VOCATIONAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING ONLINE

The Federal Government has re-launched the My Skills website which will now focus on online training for Australians looking to upskill during the COVID-19 pandemic.

My Skills is the national directory of VET organisations and courses that enables you to search and compare VET courses and training providers.

Through the My Skills website you will now be able to search the increased online offerings of registered training organisations (RTOs) and vocational education and training (VET) options currently available.
