Defibrillator Awareness Month

For Defibrillator Awareness Month, we are committed to ensuring the widespread awareness and implementation of public access defibrillators in the community.

Per day, an average of 90 Australians are affected by a sudden cardiac arrest outside of a hospital setting. The use of a defibrillator within the first few minutes after a cardiac arrest can increase the chances of survival to as much as 70%. For every minute that passes without defibrillation, chances of survival decrease by 10%, meaning early access to a defibrillator can be the difference between life and death.


